



The informal committee of representatives from the governing bodies of the municipalities participating in the agreement for paramedic services with Curtis Ambulance will meet at 4:30 pm on Monday, August 4, 2014 in the Adams County Community Center located at 569 North Cedar Street, Adams. The agenda will be as follows:

- 1. Listen to proposal from representatives of Curtis Ambulance and Adams County Emergency Services (ACES) regarding possible assignment from Curtis to ACES of provider responsibilities under the existing ambulance/paramedic services agreement and discuss such proposal with them.**

- 2. Convene in closed session pursuant to sec. 19.85(1)(e) Wis. Stats. for the purpose of discussing and possibly formulating a collective negotiation strategy to be utilized in responding to the assignment proposal. (If formulated, such strategy will be presented to the governing bodies of each of the respective municipalities for formal consideration and action.)**

- 3. Reconvene in open session and schedule, if necessary, the time and agenda of a future committee meeting.**

A quorum of members of the Common Council may be present, but no Council action will be taken.
